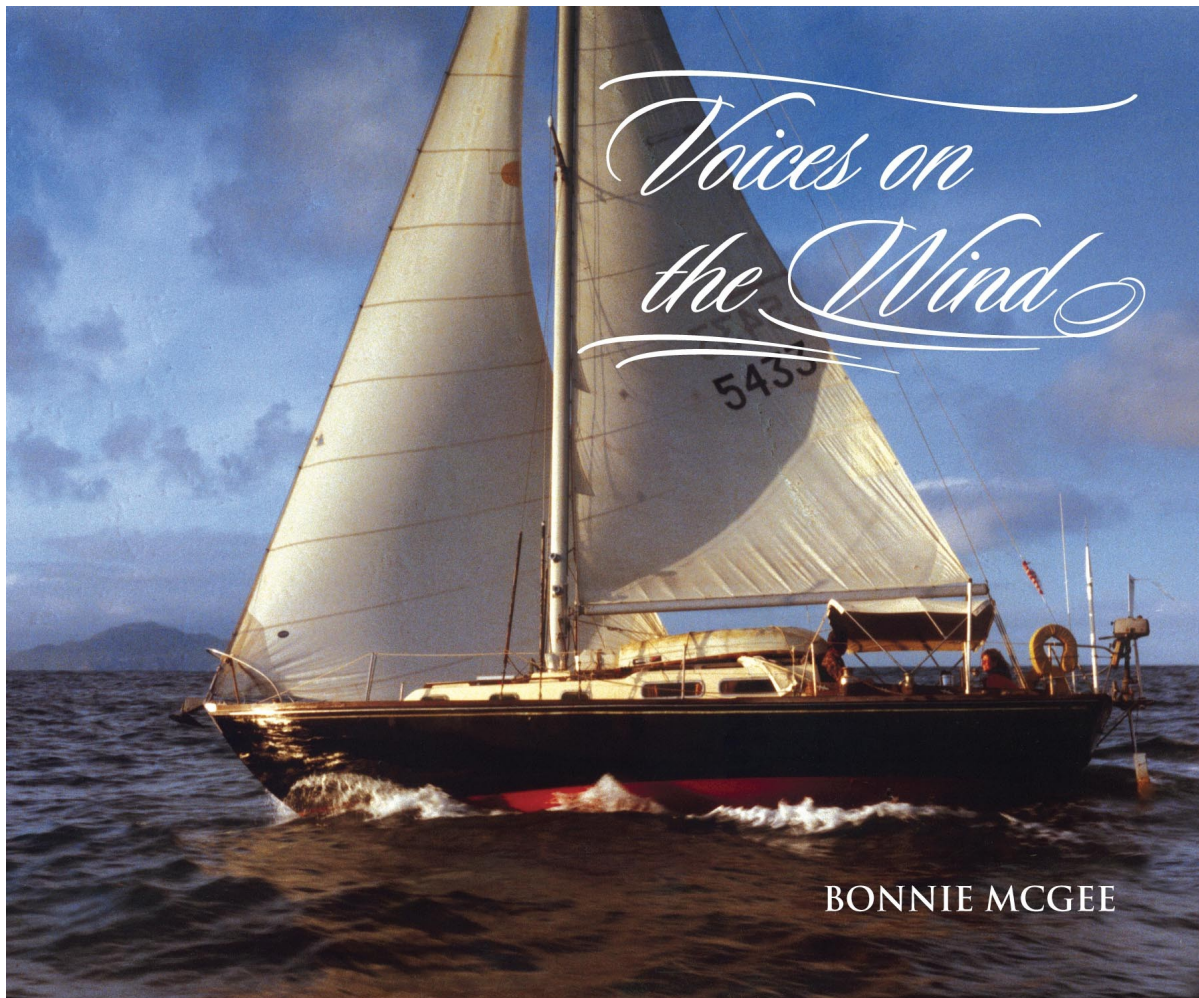


Announcing



Voices on the Wind is a collection of stories and inspiring photographs from a 4 1/2 year circumnavigation on a 33 ft. sailboat. Often thought-provoking and always entertaining, each story takes the reader to a remote backwater, from Polynesia to an aboriginal outpost in Australia, to the islands of New Guinea, and finally to the treacherous coast of Africa.

In the introduction, four-time circumnavigator, Webb Chiles, calls these stories “the distillation of what a sensitive woman took away from the land and the sea.” They cut to the essence of what makes a difficult journey worthwhile: the interaction with other cultures, and the power of those interactions to make us question all we thought we knew.

Beautifully bound as 10x12 coffee table book, *Voices on the Wind* is the perfect gift for sailors, armchair travelers, and students of the human condition.
